MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING MONDAY 14 MAY 2017

Chairman's Report

The Chairman reported that the Parish Council had been working very hard on several issues in particular inconsiderate and illegal parking, speeding vehicles and residents' safety.

The Parish Council had been trying to establish a replacement Post Office but this did not look like it would be possible to find a business who was willing to take on the strict regulations from the Post Office.

The Village still did not have a new box which meant that super-fast broadband was still not available, and coverage was fairly patchy.

The Chairman thanked the Village Hall Committee for the Easter Treasure Hunt which had gone very well and was a good addition to the village events.

Financial Report

A copy of the statement of accounts for 2016/17 had been circulated. The members discussed and accepted the financial statement with the Chairman thanking the Clerk for a concise presentation of Parish accounts.

Village Priorities

The members agreed that:

- Residents safety should continue to be considered a primary objective to be targeted during the next year, including Car parking and Traffic.
- Playground Equipment replacement would be investigated.
- The Parish Council would investigate grants for a defibrillator for the village.
- The Parish Council would continue to note and monitor complaints from residents regarding A-Frames on display and noise from the Red Lion.

There was no other business and the Chairman thanked everyone and declared the meeting closed.
